Location

The course will be held at Embassy Suites, 3006 Mooretown Road, Williamsburg, Virginia 23185.

This location offers easy access to the entire Williamsburg area. There are numerous attractions including Busch Gardens, Colonial Williamsburg, Jamestown, Ripley's Believe It Or Not, and movie theatres. Please consult the front desk staff for suggestions and directions.

***Newport News-Williamsburg International Airport
(closest airport)***

Exit the airport turning left onto highway 143 (Jefferson Avenue). Take highway 143 to I-64 west. Take I-64 for approximately 21.1 miles to exit 234A (highway 199 east - Lightfoot). Take highway 199 for 0.9 miles to Mooretown Road East. Continue on Mooretown Road for 4.1 miles. Embassy Suites is on your left.

Richmond International Airport

Exit the airport. Proceed to I-64 east. Take I-64 east for approximately 37.9 miles to exit 234A (highway 199 east - Lightfoot). Take highway 199 for 0.9 miles to Mooretown Road East. Continue on Mooretown Road for 4.1 miles. Embassy Suites is on your left.

Norfolk International Airport

Exit the airport. Proceed to I-64 west. Take I-64 west for approximately 47.8 miles to exit 234A (highway 199 east - Lightfoot). Take highway 199 for 0.9 miles to Mooretown Road East. Continue on Mooretown Road for 4.1 miles. Embassy Suites is on your left.

Shopping

Embassy Suites is located 2.4 miles from the Williamsburg Premium Outlets. This mall has 135 shops including Bose, Liz Claiborne, Nike, Reebok, Eddie Bauer, Tommy Hilfiger, Nautica, Banana Republic, Ralph Lauren, Coach, Hugo Boss, and Guess.
